

CITY OF RUTLAND, VERMONT
Committee of the Whole Minutes
Thursday, July 21, 2016

Members Present: President Notte, Aldermen Etori, Allaire, Tommola, Bloomer, Donahue, Davis, Depoy, and Larson.

The meeting started at 5:30. After brief discussion the committee voted to move into executive session—Davis, Allaire first motion, unanimous; Allaire, Davis second motion, eight yes, one no (Donahue). Prior to the votes it was determined that the preference of the committee was to have the executive session consist of just the aldermen and city attorney.

The committee came out of executive session at 6:46 (Davis, Donahue). Three motions were then made:

1. To recommend to the full Board to direct the City Attorney to request the full abstract and application for Rutland's resettlement program from USCRI/VRRP. This motion (Allaire, Davis) passed unanimously.
2. To recommend to the full Board to direct the City Attorney to inquire as to the actions of the Mayor and VRRP, and review these actions for compliance with the charter and any other applicable law, including the role of the Board of Aldermen going forward and whether there was any need of commitment of municipal resources to apply. This motion (Larson, Depoy) passed unanimously.
3. Recommend to the full Board to refer the issue of a review of Chapter 9 of the charter regarding the Mayor to the Charter & Ordinance Committee. This motion (Allaire, Davis) passed eight to one (Donahue).

The committee then moved to adjourn (Davis, Larson).
