This interim allocation may be renewed for a period not to exceed two years at the discretion of the City upon request of the applicant. Any such renewal must be requested and granted in writing.

Allocation shall become permanent upon completion of the project within the time required above.

The fee associated with this allocation shall be non-refundable except that 50% of such fee may be refunded if the applicant/property owner abandons the project and voluntarily gives up the allocation in writing within two years of issuance.

This Allocation runs with the land.
