The C+O met at 5:30 on 11/7/17 to discuss changing the wording of our taxi ordinance to address outside taxi companies working in the city without a permit to operate.

How this issue was first noticed was when a Rutland police officer ticketed an outside taxi and the taxi company protested the fine.

The committee voted 2-1 to send the ordinance to City Attorney Bloomer to change the language to reflect that Taxis coming to drop off a passenger are OK but not allowing these same taxis to pick up passengers from the City to be delivered anywhere.

Hopefully Matt will have language that we can address at our next regular meeting.
