

**CITY OF RUTLAND
BOARD OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS
WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 25, 2017**

Present: Mayor Louras, President Notte, Commissioner Wennberg, Clerk Heck, Zoning Administrator Tara Kelly and Project Manager Sears.

Mayor Louras called the meeting to order at 2:28pm.

Zoning Administrator Kelly submitted a list of proposed order of priority needs for E911 street names, and/or building/resident numbers. Zoning Administrator Kelly had the fire department, PD and regional ambulance prioritize a list of needed E911 changes and presented those findings to the members of the Board.

Zoning administrator Kelly then asked how she should handle some of those results and asked the Board to begin the process of updating E911. The Board asked Zoning Administrator Kelly to start with the top priorities and to continue to update the Board with her progress.

Zoning Administrator Kelly also requested input from the Board on a new planned sub-division within the city. There was brief debate as all of the questions requested of the Zoning Administrator were answered.

Commissioner Wennberg noted the issue of bridge naming and sought input from the other members. Mayor Louras asked the Clerk to reach out to David Zsido, asking him to attend their next meeting so the Board may finalize the "official" naming of the Dorr Bridge.

Mayor Louras moved to adjourn at 3:13pm.
