

**CITY OF RUTLAND
BOARD OF HIGHWAY
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2017**

Present: Mayor Louras, President Notte, PA Magro, Commissioner Wennberg, Project Manager Sears, Administrator Tara Kelly and Mr. Zsido.

Mayor Louras called the meeting to order at 2:15pm.

Dorr Drive Bridge

Mayor Louras welcomed Mr. Zsido to the meeting and asked if he had an update. After a brief discussion with the Board discussing design, concept and costs, Mr. Zsido stated he would check with the Marine Corps League to discuss these items and report back to the Board.

Commissioner Wennberg made a motion that the Board of Highway Commissioners officially designate the bridge of River Street, also known as Dorr Drive Bridge, spanning above Otter Creek the Aldo Manfredi and Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Bridge. Motion passed.

E911 Update

Administrator Kelly presented a spreadsheet outlining the E911 coding regarding the Rutland Shopping Plaza. She stated the post office address is Rutland Shopping Plaza where as the police department refers to the address as Shopping Plaza Road. Mayor Louras made a motion to reaffirm the use of Shopping Plaza Road and instruct the E911 Coordinator to number businesses 1 – 38 accordingly. Motion passed.

Mayor Louras instructed Administrator Kelly to add freight Street to the E911 map. Mayor Louras made a motion to ensure Freight Street is adopted as a City street and Jeffords Train Station be recognized on Freight Street. Motion passed.

The Board discussed signage for private drives. Mayor Louras made a motion for private road signs will have a color of brown, border of white and letters PVT included in each sign. Motion passes.
