

**CITY OF RUTLAND
BOARD OF HIGHWAY
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12, 2017**

Present: Mayor Allaire, President Davis, Engineer Rotondo, Clerk Heck, and Zoning Administrator Tara Kelly. Also present Treasurer Wilton.

Mayor Allaire called the meeting to order at 3:51 PM.

E911 Update

Zoning Administrator Kelly came before the Board to continue discussion on the E911 project she has been working on. Ms. Kelly noted an issue with Rotary Park and the entrance on North Street. The address was 17 North Street which already has a home at that location. Ms. Kelly asked the Board to re-name the entrance. The Board so moved to name the entrance Rotary Park Drive, eliminating 17 North Street. **Motion passed.**

Ms. Kelly then brought the issue of Highland Avenue and the upper portion of Highland Avenue being confused by Public Safety individuals. Ms. Kelly explained the criteria on changing the name of the street, which met with some discomfort from the Board. There was a good deal of discussion about the process.

Ms. Kelly then asked about Rutland Street which is also called Rutland Avenue. Ms. Kelly asked the Board to keep it on its radar.

Ms. Kelly also noted Howe Center and the entrance from Porter Place. Ms. Kelly explained the concerns with E911 and how the homes were numbered and the continuation of the street directly into Howe Center. The Board also noted there is a Porter Place and Porter Street. The Board also discussed the issues with GPS directing large trucks down Porter Place and not Scale Avenue.

The issues will remain in committee.
