

**CITY OF RUTLAND, VERMONT
BOARD OF HIGHWAY
WEDNESDAY, MAY 25, 2016**

Present: Mayor Louras, Commissioner Wennberg, and City Clerk Heck. President Notte was absent.

Mayor Louras called the meeting to order at 2:52PM.

Commissioner Wennberg brought one request to the Board. Commissioner Wennberg asked to approve a request to place a gate at the South end of Cleveland Avenue to help secure the removal of contaminated debris from the old Linda Lee Dress factory. Commissioner Wennberg explained in detail how the contaminated debris would be removed, and the need for the fence. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Wennberg) to allow the temporary installation of a gated fence across the dead end part of Cleveland Avenue, South of the GMP solar access gate, and because of a potential need to access water & sewer infrastructure, NO debris, equipment or storage may be placed on the City Right of Way. **Motion passed.**
