

**CITY OF RUTLAND  
BOARD OF HIGHWAY  
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2015**

Present: Mayor Louras, President Notte, Commissioner Wennberg, Project Manager Sears, and City Clerk Henry Heck. Also present was a large group of citizens to speak on the Dorr Drive widening issue.

Meeting was called to order at 2:20 pm.

Mayor Louras wanted to speak on the issue of widening Dorr Drive. The Mayor asked engineer Rotondo to explain the cost difference associated with the widening part of the project. The Board then spent the next hour hearing input from interested parties and gathering facts. Upon the completion of a very thorough discussion a motion was made and seconded (Louras, Notte) stating that "Dorr Drive when paved, will be configured with nine (9) foot travel lanes with equal shoulders on either side, delineated with fog lines no later than April 30, 2016, and with appropriate stencils and signage". **Motion passed.**

A motion was made and seconded (Wennberg, Notte) recommending to the Board of finance that all bids received to widen Dorr Drive be rejected. **Motion passed.**
