

**Minutes**  
**May 22, 2019**

- III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – May 8, 2019.**

- IV. NEW BUSINESS – Tree planting as it Relates to Allergies.**

PG discussed an article regarding how the planting of male tree species is contributing to allergies. He volunteered to forward the article to the Commission.

- V. OLD BUSINESS – Tiny House Discussion.**

LW reported on tiny house zoning for Brandon and West Rutland and said Clarendon and Wallingford's tiny house zoning is available online. LW said Jonas Rosenthal would be available all day Tuesday to discuss Castleton's tiny house zoning.

**Review District Table of Draft Zoning.**

The Commission made some recommendations to the draft Zoning District Table. There was discussion regarding:

- adding “tiny house” under Residential Use Types;
- changing the description regarding Historically Significant Gateways to strengthen the goal of maintaining historic structures;

- adding PUD as a mechanism for allowing mobile home parks in areas outside of the Industrial Districts and changing the 1 acre to ½ acre as the size of land a PUD can be accomplished on;
- limiting the Educational Park District to the existing campus and lands currently owned by the College of St. Joseph; and
- applying standards for administrative site plan review to Day Care – Family.

The next meeting will be a discussion of Section 3 – Use Regulations & Dimensional Standards.
