6:45 PM Public Hearing: Rutland Permanent Supportive Housing

Members present; President Davis, Aldermen Humphrey *Ettori, Tommola, *Mattis, Gillam, Clifford, and Whitcomb. Also present; Mayor Allaire, Barbara Spaulding, Melissa Disorda, Donnaleen Farwell, Elizabeth Kulas, Brennan Duffy and City Clerk Heck. Alderman Ettori arrived at 6:47 PM. Alderwoman Mattis arrived at 6:51 PM.

Melissa Disorda, assistant housing developer for the Housing Trust of Rutland County spoke on homeless individual adults in Rutland County. Ms. Disorda spoke on the project giving a very detailed account of its need, scope and cost. Ms. Disorda noted the location, the previous IHM School and how ideal the location is being near downtown. Ms. Disorda noted the various rehab items, including wiring and plumbing needed to bring the building to code, cosmetic and building layout. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$5.6 million dollars. Ms. Disorda asked the City to apply for a Block Grant in the amount of \$750,000. At the conclusion of Ms. Disorda's presentation, Board of Alderman President Davis asked if anyone from the public had a question or comment. Seeing none, President Davis noted a motion to close the hearing would be in order. Alderman Gillam so moved and Alderman Clifford seconded. **Motion passed.**
