TOPIC: RUTLAND CITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN-----NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The Alderman Public Safety Committee met in the downstairs conference room of Rutland City Hall on Thursday, July 31, 2014 to address to issues.

The First was a proclamation which required the Mayor's signature adopting the National Incident Management System as the tool to be utilized by the City of Rutland for overall emergency management structure.

Alderman Donohue moved that the Committee recommend to the full Board of Alderman that the Mayor be authorized to sign the proclamation. The motion passed unanimously 3-0.

The Second item of discussion was the City's Emergency Response Plan, which the Mayor indicated would be submitted to the Local Emergency Response Committee, then to the State Emergency Response Commission for potential changes if required. There was a brief discussion that several names on the Emergency Call List would require updating and the Mayor indicated he would have Chief Schlacter take care of that matter. It was agreed that the document was quite inclusive of Emergency contacts and response for situations that may occur. Needed was a motion to authorize the President of the Board of Alderman to sign the City's Emergency Response Plan.

Alderman Brodowski so moved, and the motion passed unanimously 3-0.

These being the only two (2) items on the agenda, the meeting adjourne
