Topic: Mayfield Road Drainage issues.

The Public Works committee met at Mayfield Rd. in Rutland on Sunday afternoon to view the newly paved and curbed road. Residents on the street had some concerns with how larger rain storms and snow storms were affecting the area at the end of the street which is a dead end street which slopes to the dead end. Water appears to be coming to the end of the street and causing erosion problems as it leaves the end of the road. Mrs. Godzik's driveway is showing signs of being undermined by the runoff as well as the end of the street. We viewed the new pavement, asphalt curbing, as well as the rip rap at the end of the street which is designed to help with the integrity of the end of the pavement and bank. The other issue is when it snows or runoff freezes City plow trucks have been getting stuck on the ice that pools at the end of the street.

On Monday we met to get some feedback from Comm. Wennberg as to what is going to be done to help with the several situations occurring at the end of the street. He told us that the department is going to work on the very end of the street to help with the drainage and monitor the area to see if the fixes are working. He also said the department will possibly use smaller trucks to plow the road as it is only a short street and rather narrow. The smaller trucks should have an easier time getting out of there and if they need to be pulled out if stuck it will only require another vehicle instead of heavy equipment to come down and pull one of the 5 ton rigs out. Comm. Wennberg will report back to us with the conditions on the street as winter goes forward. This report is FYI only. No action was taken. The issue will remain in committee so we may get reports as needed.
